A piscatorial preface

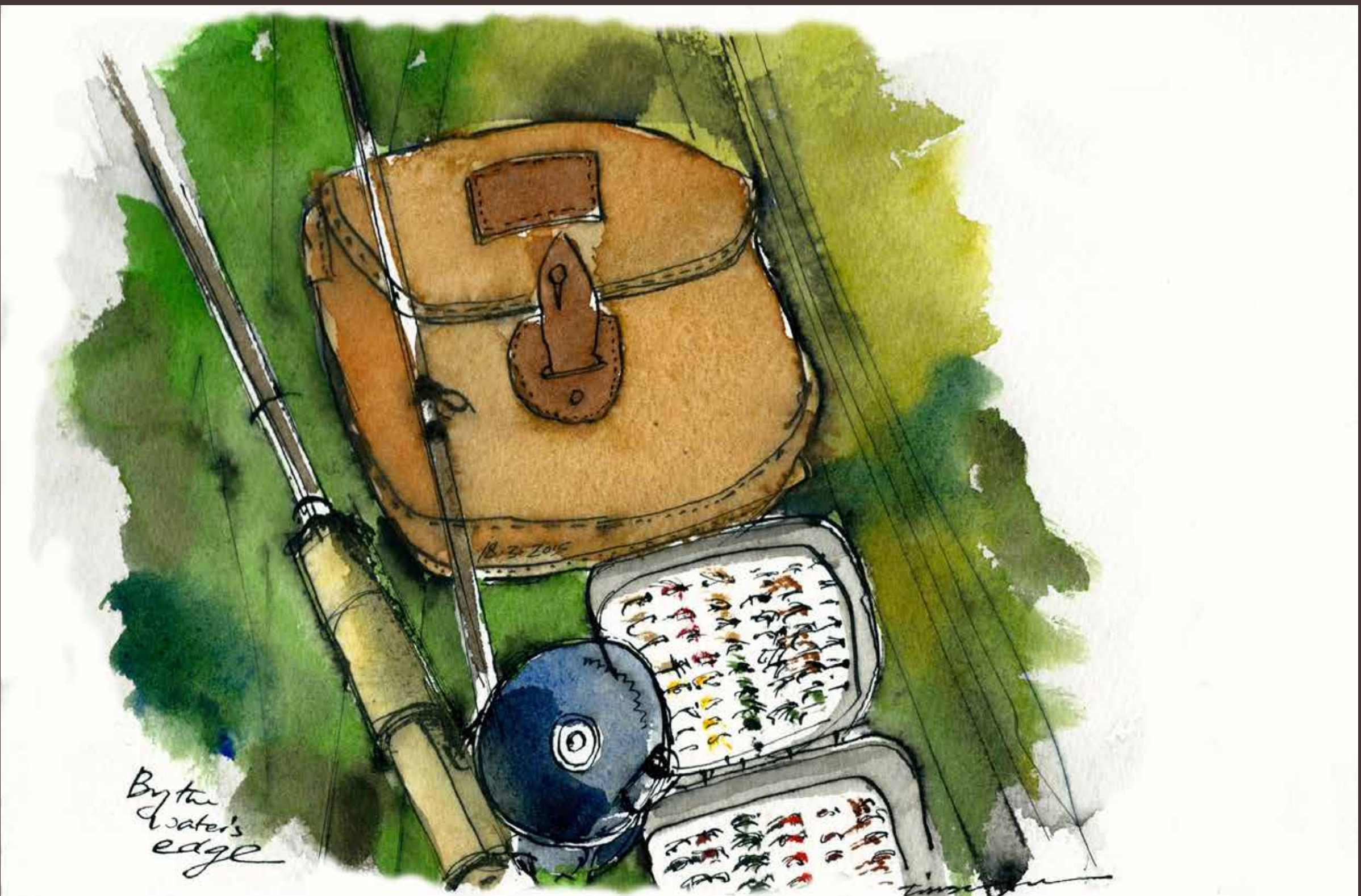
When your best friend Richard returns to Scotland and with his wife and eldest daughter to buy and run a fishing hotel you feel you have to answer to the call to come and visit.

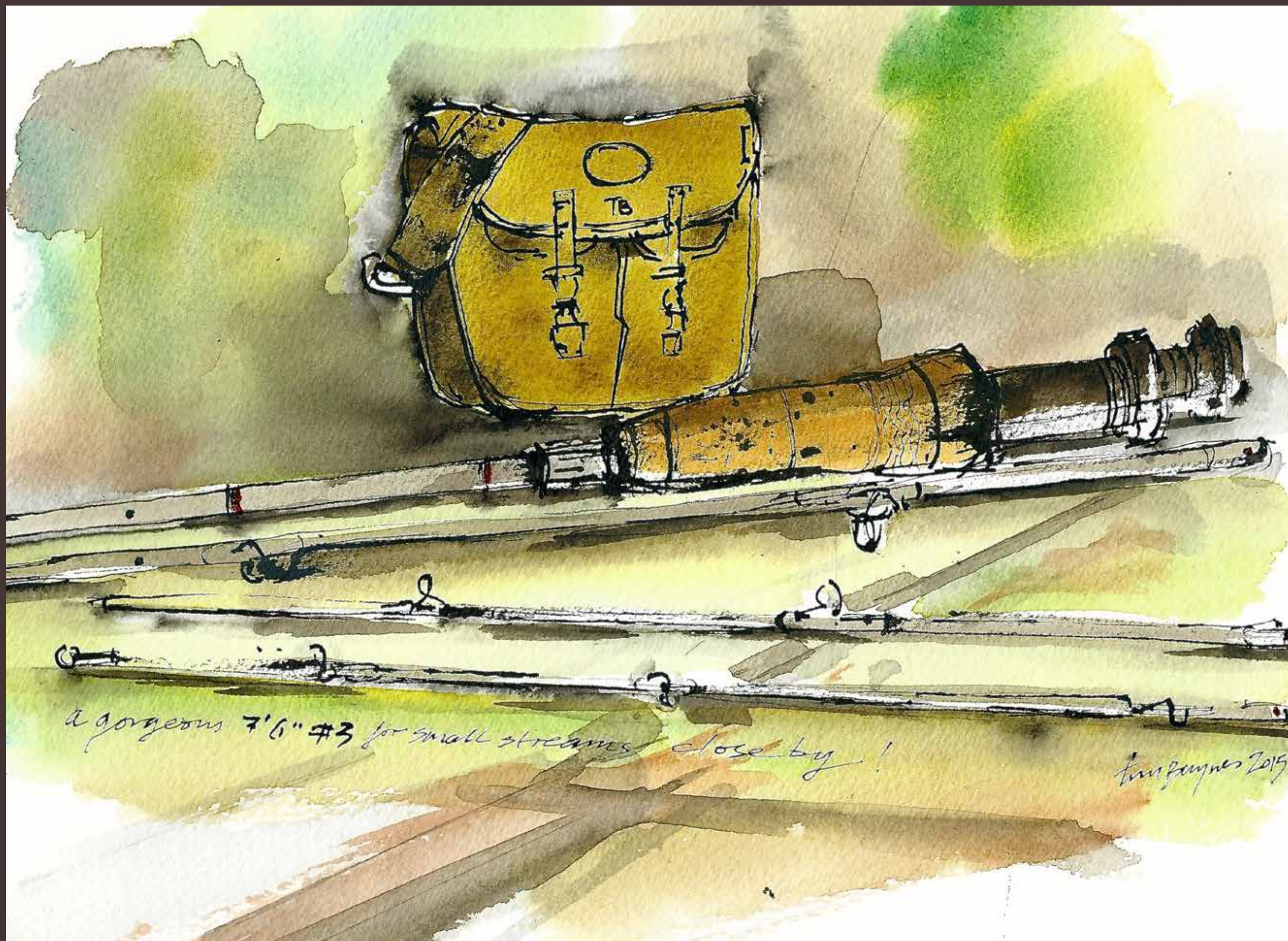
By happenstance you get bitten by the fishing, fly fishing bug! You have no notion of how much there is to learn.

Every piscatorial drawing done to date is here. I hope you enjoy them. And perhaps one day make it up to the Scourie Hotel and it's local waters.



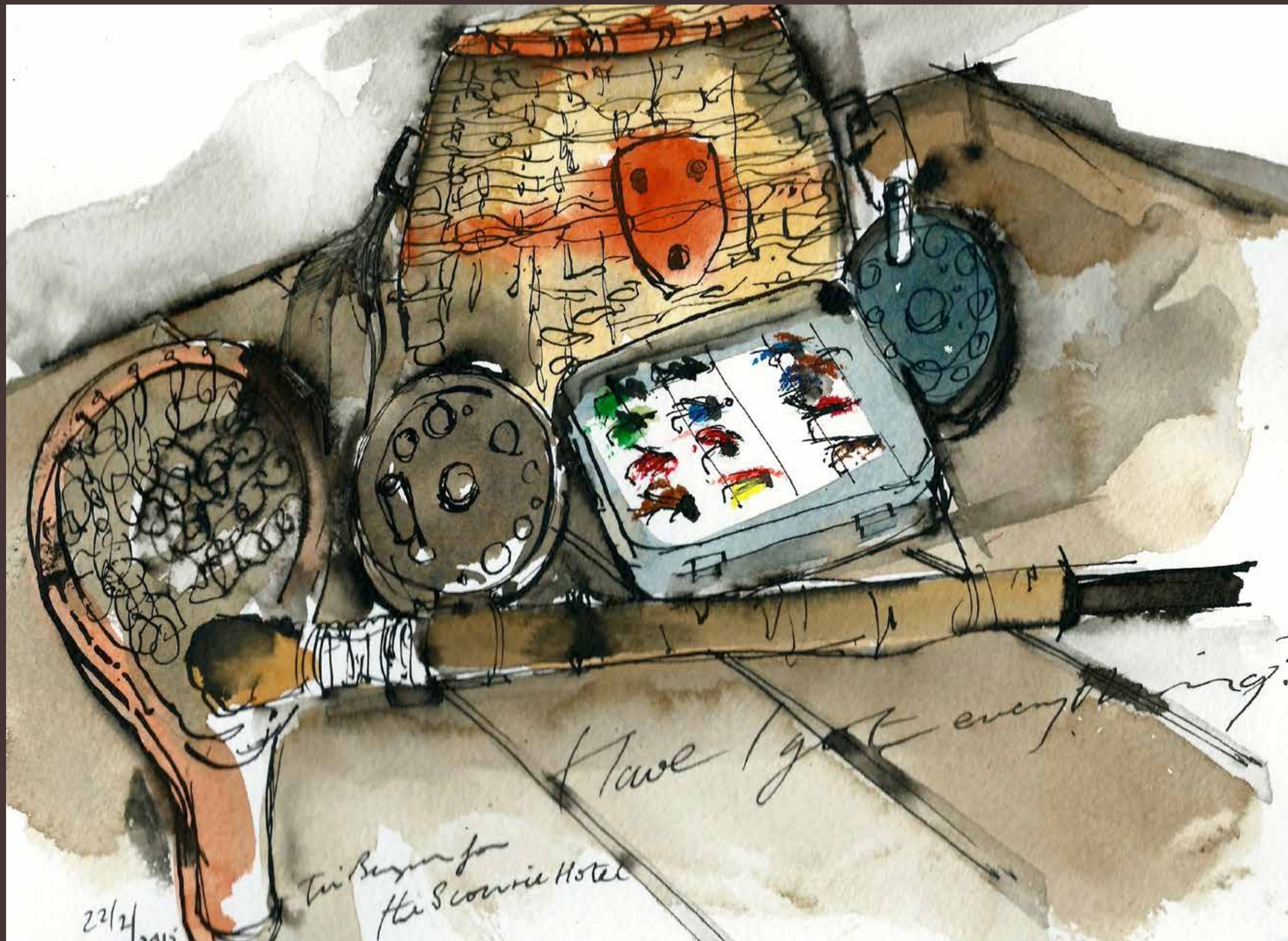
